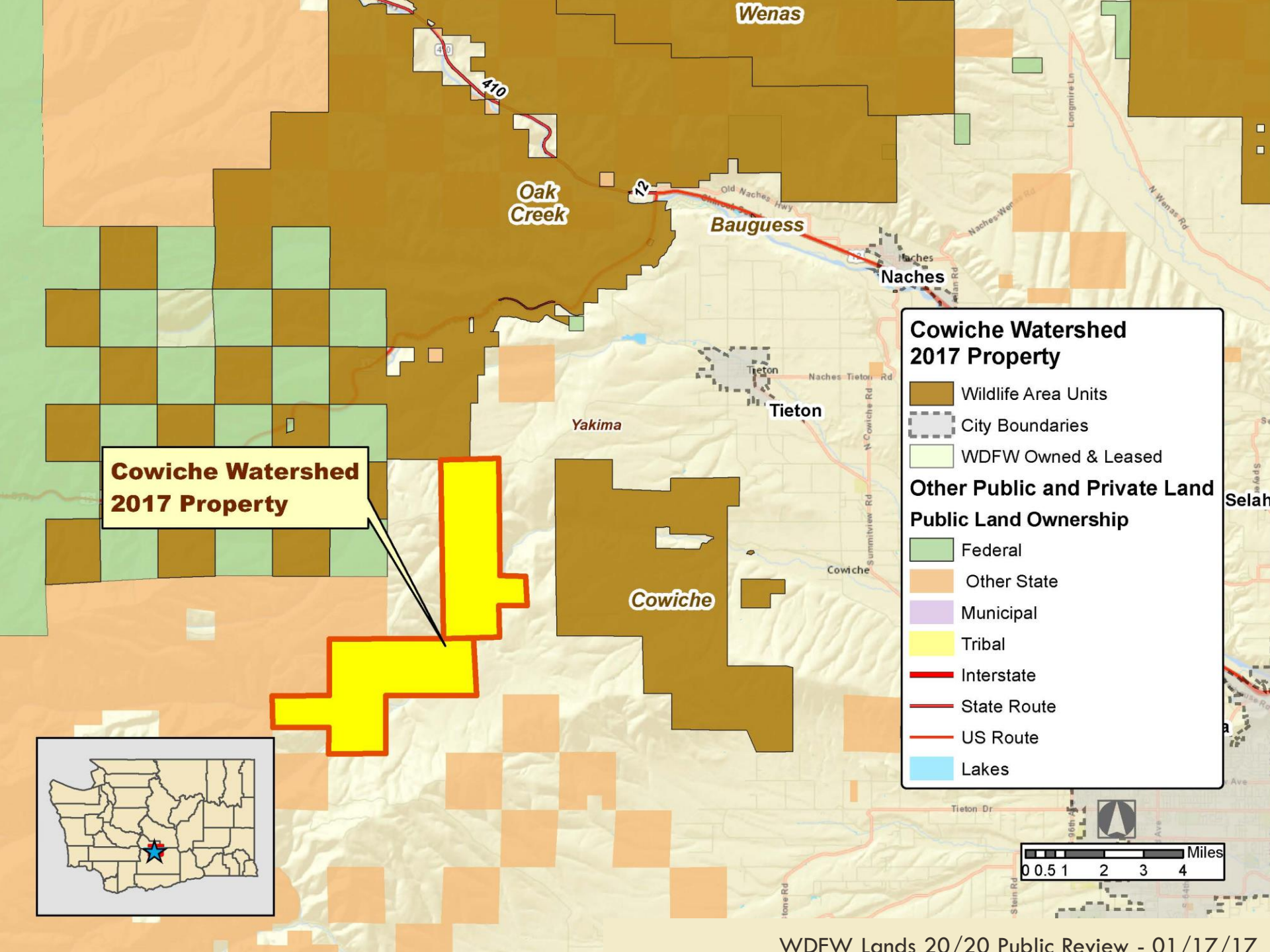




WDFW Lands 20/20 Public Review - 01/17/17

<p>Project Description</p>	<p>This project the first phase of a larger project in the Cowiche Watershed area west of Yakima on the east slopes of the Cascades and includes large tracts of intact priority habitats including: shrub-steppe, oak woodland, riparian, aspen, and ponderosa pine, and over 6 miles of instream habitat supporting steelhead and bull trout recovery.</p>
