

Grayland Properties – 1,750 Acres Grays Harbor County

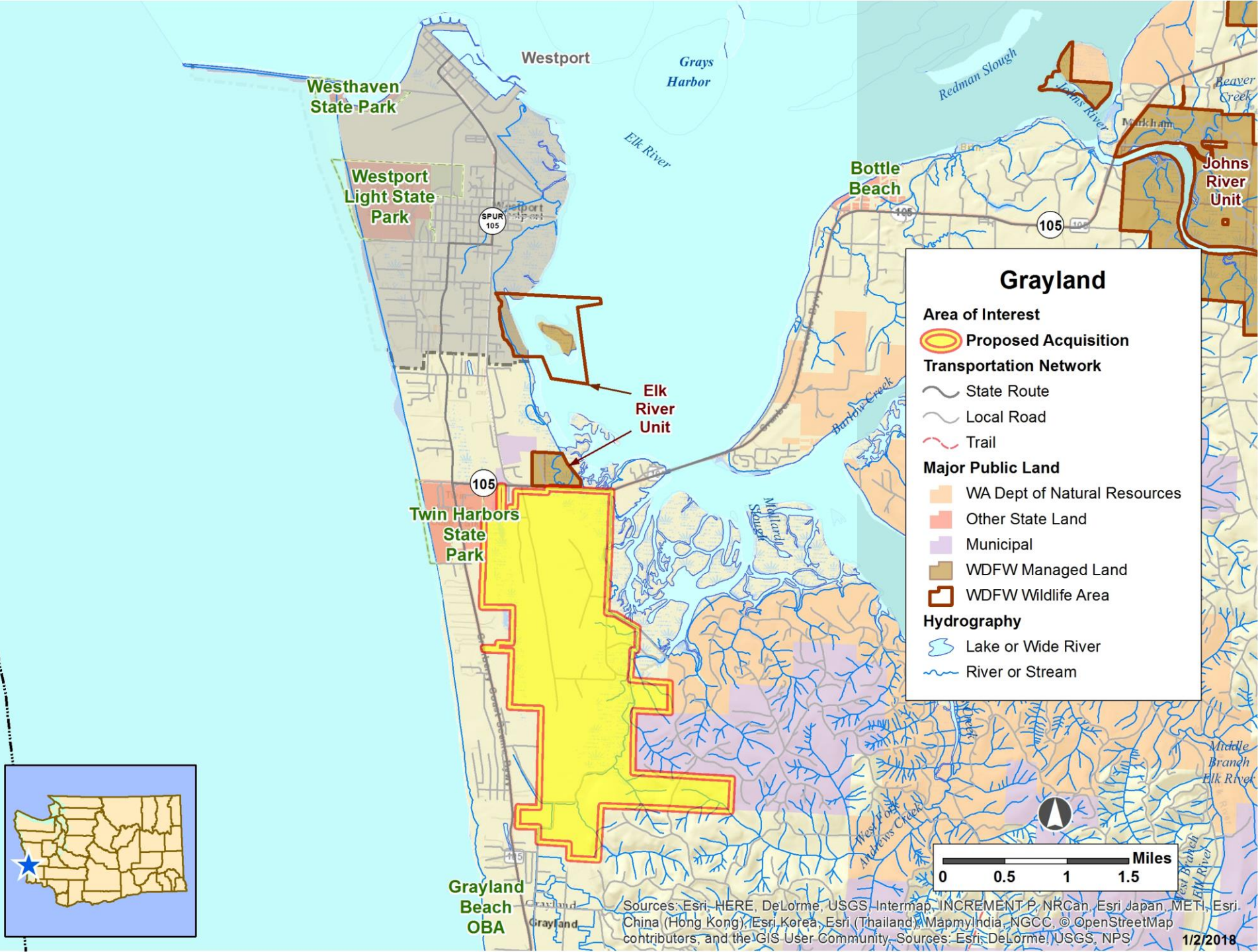

Project benefits: Public access for waterfowl and elk hunting, wildlife viewing, and other recreational opportunities.
