

Columbia River Compact/Joint State Action Notice

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE MODIFIED:

Treaty Indian Winter Commercial Season

- Effective 6:00 PM Friday February 26, 2010 the treaty Indian winter gillnet fishery in John Day Pool is closed.
- Effective 6:00 PM Wednesday March 3, 2010 the treaty Indian winter gillnet fishery in The Dalles Pool is closed.
- The treaty Indian winter gillnet fishery in Bonneville Pool remains closed.
- The treaty Indian platform / hook and line fishery in Zone 6 (Bonneville to McNary Dams) will remain open, except that sturgeon sales are prohibited. Sturgeon may be retained for subsistence purposes if measuring between 38 and 54 inches in fork length in Bonneville Pool, and measuring between 43 and 54 inches in fork length in The Dalles and John Day pools. All other sales regulations remain in place for Zone 6.
- No Compact/Joint State hearings are scheduled at this time.
