
COLUMBIA RIVER COMPACT/JOINT STATE ACTION NOTICE

Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife

April 28, 2010

The states of Oregon and Washington met today to review recreational sturgeon fisheries in the Columbia River upstream of Bonneville Dam and took the following actions:

The Dalles Pool (The Dalles Dam upstream to John Day Dam)

Effective (12:01 AM) Thursday May 6, 2010: the retention of sturgeon in the Columbia River and tributaries between The Dalles Dam and John Day Dam is prohibited.

Once this action is in effect, all three pools between Bonneville and McNary dams will be closed to retention of sturgeon. Catch and release is allowed in all pools, except for within the designated sanctuaries.

All other permanent angling regulations remain in effect.
