Fisheries under consideration: Recreational fishery for sturgeon in The Dalles Pool

- Recreational fisheries closed to sturgeon retention February 21 in Bonneville Pool and March 1 in John Day Pool.
- The 2010 guideline for the recreational fishery in The Dalles Pool is 300 white sturgeon.
- An estimated 264 white sturgeon (88% of guideline) were harvested January 1 through April 25 in The Dalles Pool (Table 1).
- Approximately 70% of the harvest so far this year occurred from January 1 through April 18. The remaining 30% (78 fish) came the week of April 19-25. No fish have been observed in-sample since April 25.
- Harvest has averaged 36 fish per week during the past three weeks. If this trend continues, the guideline could be met as early as May 2.

Joint Staff Recommendation – Zone 6 Recreational Sturgeon Fisheries

Close The Dalles Pool sturgeon recreational fishery to retention effective 12:01 a.m. Monday, May 3, 2010.

- All fishing for sturgeon is prohibited from May through July in the sturgeon spawning sanctuary that runs from John Day Dam 2.4 miles downstream to the Rufus grain elevator.
