2013 Non-Indian Summer Chinook Commercial Fishery		
Season	9 PM Sunday June 16 to 5 AM Monday June 17, 2013	(8 hours)
Area	Zones 1-5	
Sanctuaries:	Grays River, Elokommin-A, Cowlitz River, Kalama-A, Lewis-A, Washougal and Sandy Rivers.	
Gear:	Drift gill nets. 8-inch minimum mesh size. Nets not specifically authorized for use in this fishery may be onboard the vessel if properly stored. A properly stored net is defined as a net on a drum that is fully covered by a tarp (canvas or plastic) and bound with a minimum of ten revolutions of rope with a diameter of 3/8 (0.375) inches or greater.	
Allowable Sales:	Chinook, sockeye, white sturgeon, and shad. A maximum of 5 white sturgeon may be possessed or sold by each participating vessel during each calendar week (Sunday through Saturday) that the fishery is open. Limit applies to mainstem only. The Youngs Bay Select Area remains open under a 2 white sturgeon weekly retention limit.	
Additional:	A 24-hour quick reporting rule is in effect for Washington buyers.
