
COLUMBIA RIVER COMPACT/JOINT STATE ACTION NOTICE

The Joint States met today and took the following action:

<i>2014 Bonneville Pool Summer Recreational White Sturgeon Fishery</i>	
Season:	July 11-12 (Fri-Sat) and July 18-19 (Fri-Sat), 2014 (4 days)
Area:	Mainstem Columbia River from Bonneville Dam upstream to The Dalles Dam, including adjacent tributaries. <u>Sturgeon Spawning Sanctuary:</u> Angling for sturgeon prohibited from The Dalles Dam downstream 1.8 miles to a line from the east (upstream) dock at the Port of The Dalles boat ramp straight across to a marker on the Washington shore during May 1 through July 31.
Allowable Catch	White sturgeon between 38-inches and 54-inches fork length.

- Catch and release allowed during non-retention period

THE STATE OF OREGON MADE THE FOLLOWING ANNOUNCEMENT:

<i>2014 The Dalles Pool Recreational White Sturgeon Fishery – Oregon State Action</i>
Effective 12:01 AM Friday August 1, 2014, close The Dalles Pool and adjacent tributaries to white sturgeon retention.
