THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

Non-Indian Commercial Salmon Fishery:

AREA: Mouth upstream to Beacon Rock, Zones 1-5

DATES: 7 AM Monday, October 8 to 7 AM Friday, October 12
7 AM Monday, October 15 to 7 AM Friday, October 19
7 AM Monday, October 22 to 7 AM Friday, October 26

GEAR: No mesh size restrictions

SANCTUARIES: Grays Bay, Elokomin-A, Cowlitz River, Kalama-A, Lewis-A, Washougal River, and Sandy River

ALLOWABLE SALE: Salmon only. No sturgeon sales allowed.

Non-Indian Commercial Salmon Fishery

AREA: From a line between Harrington Point in Washington to Settler Point in Oregon upstream to Beacon Rock

DATES: 7 AM Monday, October 29 to 7 PM Wednesday, October 31

GEAR: No mesh size restrictions

SANCTUARIES: Elokomin-A, Cowlitz River, Kalama-A, Lewis-A, Washougal River, and Sandy River

ALLOWABLE SALE: Salmon only. No sturgeon sales allowed.
