LOWER COLUMBIA RIVER SPORT FISHERY

The states of Washington and Oregon met today and took the following action:

EFFECTIVE 12:01 AM SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 18, 2005 THE COLUMBIA RIVER FROM THE ROCKY POINT/TONGUE POINT LINE TO BONNEVILLE DAM WILL BE CLOSED FOR THE RETENTION OF CHINOOK SALMON.

The retention of hatchery coho and hatchery steelhead will continue to be allowed.

Bouy 10 will continue to remain open for Chinook, hatchery coho and hatchery steelhead.
