THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

NON-INDIAN COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY

Target coho fishery

Area:	Mouth upstream to Longview Bridge
Sanctuaries:	Grays Bay, Elokomina-A, and Abernathy Creek sanctuaries are in place.
Dates:	7 AM to 7 PM - Monday, September 18, 2000 7 AM to 7 PM - Tuesday, September 19, 2000 7 AM to 7 PM - Wednesday, September 20, 2000
Gear:	6-inch maximum mesh size restriction, unslackened floater gill nets only
Allowable Sale:	Salmon and sturgeon

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

NON-INDIAN COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY

Target chinook fishery

Area:	From a line projected from Warrior Rock to Red Buoy No.4 thence to fishing boundary marker on Bachelor Island upstream to Beacon Rock.
Sanctuaries:	Washougal and Sandy River sanctuaries are in place.
Dates:	8 PM Tuesday, September 19, 2000 to 6 AM Wednesday, September 20, 2000
Gear:	8-inch minimum and 9-3/4 inch maximum mesh size restriction
Allowable Sale:	Salmon and sturgeon

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

TREATY INDIAN COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY

Area: All Zone 6

Sanctuaries: Standard dam and river mouth sanctuaries and standard Spring Creek sanctuaries in place.

Dates: 6 AM Tuesday, September 19, 2000 to 6 PM Saturday September 23, 2000

Gear: no mesh size restriction

Allowable Sale: Salmon, steelhead, walleye and shad
