THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

TREATY INDIAN COMMERCIAL FISHERY:

DATES:	6:00 AM Thursday, April 25 to 6:00 PM, Saturday, April 27, 2002
AREA:	All of Zone 6
SANCTUARIES:	All standard sanctuaries remain in effect with the exception of the Spring Creek Hatchery sanctuary, which is not necessary at this time of year.
ALLOWABLE SALE:	Chinook salmon, steelhead, walleye, carp, and shad. Commercial sales of platform caught fish are allowed during commercial openings. Fish caught in the Wind, Klickitat, and White Salmon rivers may be sold during open commercial season.
MISCELLANEOUS REGULATIONS	Sturgeon between 4 and 5 feet may be retained for subsistence use.
