Columbia River Compact/ Joint State Action Notice Washington Dept. of Fish and Wildlife

May 28, 2003

THE FOLLOWING COLUMBIA RIVER SEASONS WERE SET:

Treaty Indian Commercial Salmon Fishery:

SEASON:	6 AM Thursday May 29 to 6PM Saturday May 31 (2 ½ days)
AREA:	All of Zone 6.
SANCTUARIES:	All standard sanctuaries in effect, except no Spring Creek Sanctuary.
GEAR:	No mesh size restrictions.
ALLOWABLE SALES:	Chinook salmon, steelhead, walleye, carp, and shad.
MISCELLANEOUS REGULATIONS:	Commercial sales of platform and hook and line caught fish are allowed through May 31. Sales of fish caught from the Yakama Nation tributary fisheries in the Wind River and Klickitat River are allowed through 6PM Saturday May 31. Fish may be sold from the Washington tributaries during the open Yakama Nation fishing periods within those areas. Sturgeon may not be sold, but sturgeon between 4 and 5 feet may be kept for subsistence use.
