THE FOLLOWING FISHERY CHANGES WILL OCCUR:

2019 Select Area Commercial Fisheries

Compact Action:

- **Rescind** the 4-hour fishing periods previously adopted for the Tongue Point Select Area on April 18, April 23–24, and April 26.
 - The South Channel fishing area remains open on these dates as previously adopted (7 PM–11 PM April 18, 10 PM April 23 – 2 AM April 24, and midnight–4 AM April 26).
- **Modify** the open hours previously adopted for the Knappa Slough Select Area on April 18–19, April 23–24, and April 25–26 as follows:
 - April 18 open **7 PM–11 PM** (4 hours)
 - April 23–24 open **10 PM–2 AM** (4 hours)
 - April 26 open **midnight–4 AM** (4 hours)
 - The Blind Slough Select Area remains open on these dates as previously adopted (7 PM–7 AM for April 18–19, April 23–24, and April 25–26)

Oregon State Action:

- **Rescind** the 4-hour fishing period previously adopted for the Youngs Bay Select Area on April 23–24.

All other previously adopted regulations specific to each site remain in effect.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A Joint State hearing via teleconference to discuss the recreational spring Chinook downstream of Bonneville Dam is scheduled for Wednesday April 17, 2019 at 1PM.
