

PUGET SOUND COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERIES HOTLINE

2019-09 Week 39 Friday September 20, at 6:00 p.m.

For the week beginning Sunday September 22 all areas are closed except as follows:

Area 6D (Dungeness Bay) will be open to:

Skiff gillnets using 5-inch minimum mesh: 7 AM to 7 PM: Daily Tuesday, September 24 - Friday, September 27 All Chinook and chum must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

Area 7 (San Juan Islands) will be open to:

Reef Nets

5 AM to 9 PM daily: Sunday, September 22 - Saturday, September 28. Reef Nets must release all chum, sockeye, unmarked coho, and unmarked Chinook. Immediate possession of a WDFW Logbook is required to retain Chinook.

Areas 7B (Bellingham Bay) will be open to:

Gillnets using 5-inch minimum mesh size: Open continuously through Midnight, November 2nd

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

Open continuously through 6 PM, November 2nd Brailing is required.

Area 8D (Tulalip Bay west of a line from Mission Beach to Hermosa Point) will be open to:

Gillnets using 5 inch minimum mesh size:

6 PM Sunday, September 22 - 8 AM. Monday, September 23

6 PM Monday, September 23 - 8 AM Thursday, September 26

6 PM Thursday, September 26 - 8 AM. Friday, September 27

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip:

7 AM to 7 PM: Monday September 23 from. Purse seines must release all Chinook.

Area 9A (Port Gamble Bay) will be open to:

Skiff gillnets with nets not to exceed 600 feet in length and 60 meshes in depth using 5-inch minimum mesh, is open continuously through 7 PM Saturday, November 2nd. All Chinook and chum must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

Area 12A (Quilcene Bay) will be open to:

Beach seines with nets not to exceed 990 feet in length and 200 meshes in depth using minimum 3-inch and maximum 4-inch mesh:

7 AM to 7 PM daily: Monday September 23 – Friday September 27 Beach seines may only retain coho
