

# PUGET SOUND COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERIES HOTLINE

2019-11 Week 40 Friday September 27, at 4:00 p.m.

# For the week beginning Sunday September 29 all areas are closed except as follows:

## Area 6D (Dungeness Bay) will be open to:

**Skiff gillnets** using 5-inch minimum mesh:

7 AM to 7 PM: Daily Monday, September 30 - Friday, October 4 All Chinook and chum must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

## Area 7 (San Juan Islands) will be open to:

## **Reef Nets**

5 AM to 9 PM daily: Sunday, September 29 - Saturday, October 5. Reef Nets must release all chum, sockeye, unmarked coho, and unmarked Chinook. Immediate possession of a WDFW Logbook is required to retain Chinook.

## Areas 7B (Bellingham Bay) will be open to:

**Gillnets** using 5-inch minimum mesh size: Open continuously through Midnight, November 2<sup>nd</sup>

## **Purse seines** with a 5 inch strip:

Open continuously through 6 PM, November 2<sup>nd</sup> Brailing is required.

## Area 8D (Tulalip Bay west of a line from Mission Beach to Hermosa Point) will be open to:

Gillnets using 5 inch minimum mesh size:

- 6 PM Sunday, September 29 8 AM. Monday, September 30
- 6 PM Monday, September 30 8 AM Thursday, October 3
- 6 PM Thursday, October 3 8 AM. Friday, October 4

#### **Purse seines** with a 5 inch strip:

7 AM to 7 PM: Tuesday October 1. Purse seines must release all Chinook.

## Area 9A (Port Gamble Bay) will be open to:

**Skiff gillnets** with nets not to exceed 600 feet in length and 60 meshes in depth using 5-inch minimum mesh, is open continuously through 7 PM Saturday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>. All Chinook and chum must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

#### Area 12A (Quilcene Bay) will be open to:

**Beach seines** with nets not to exceed 990 feet in length and 200 meshes in depth using minimum 3-inch and maximum 4-inch mesh:

7 AM to 7 PM daily: Monday September 30 – Friday October 4 Beach seines may only retain coho
