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## WASHINGTON COASTAL DUNGENESS CRAB INDUSTRY NOTICE

## Season Opening Further Delayed In Washington, Oregon and California (North of Point Arena)

On Friday December 6, 2019 coastal Dungeness crab Tri-State policy representatives from the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW), the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) agreed to further delay the opening of the 2019-20 Coastal Dungeness crab fishery from Point Area, California north to the US/Canada border through December 31, 2019 at least. This decision was based on crab condition tests conducted by WDFW, ODFW and CDFW which shows that some test areas still do not currently meet the minimum meat recovery criteria.

The Tri-State Dungeness Crab Pre-Season Testing Protocols specify that if test results show that any area does not meet the minimum meat recovery criteria (23% north of Cascade Head and 25% south of Cascade Head), a delay and additional testing are required before a season opening date can be confirmed.

A third round of meat recovery testing will be conducted sometime in mid–December, targeting completion by December 20. WDFW will provide additional information regarding the season opening as soon as possible following the completion of the upcoming tests.

Coast-wide test meat recovery results to date are found in the attached table.
