- Live box use REQUIRED for All wild (unmarked) Chinook and All Steelhead.
- Soak times must not exceed 45 minutes.
- Notice of Intent to fish any of the days in the 2020 fisheries is REQUIRED by 12 pm (Noon), October 9, 2020.
