## For the week beginning Sunday October 25<sup>th</sup> all areas are closed except as follows:

# Area 6D (Dungeness Bay) will be open to:

Skiff gillnets using 5-inch minimum mesh:

7 AM to 7 PM Daily Monday October 26 - Friday October 30 All Chinook must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

Area 7 (San Juan Islands) and 7A (Point Roberts) will be open to: Reef Nets

> 5 AM to 9 PM Daily: Sunday October 25 - Saturday October 31 Must release all sockeye, and Chinook.

Purse Seines - with a 5 inch strip:

7 AM to 6 PM Daily: Sunday October 25 - Saturday October 31 Brailing of catch and recovery boxes are required Must release all and Chinook and Coho

Gillnets using 6 ¼-inch minimum mesh:

7 AM to Midnight Daily: Sunday October 25 - Saturday October 31

Fishers are reminded that a department issued **Fish Friendly certification card is required** to participate in any Area 7 or 7A commercial salmon fisheries

## Areas 7B (Bellingham Bay) will be open to:

Gillnets using 5-inch minimum mesh:

Open continuously: 7 AM Tuesday October 27 – 4 PM Wednesday October 28 \*Whatcom Creek Zone CLOSED\*

Purse seines - with a 5 inch strip:

7 AM – 6 PM Wednesday October 28 \*Whatcom Creek Zone CLOSED to ALL GEARS \*

### Area 9A (Port Gamble Bay) will be open to:

**Skiff gillnets** with nets not to exceed 600 feet in length and 60 meshes in depth using 5-inch minimum mesh, is open continuously through 7 PM Saturday, October 31. All Chinook must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

#### Areas 12 and 12B (Hood Canal) will be open to:

**Gillnets** using 6 ¼ inch minimum mesh:

Daily: 7 AM to 8 PM Tuesday October 27 Thursday October 29 Must Release Coho

Purse Seines with a 5 inch strip:

7 AM to 6 PM Monday October 26 Must Release Coho
