Background summary:
In the face of chronic low runsizes and failure in meeting management objectives outlined in the Statewide Steelhead Management Plan WDFW implemented gear regulations and harvest restrictions for the 2020/21 coastal steelhead fishing season to increase the number of fish on the spawning grounds. Department staff will provide the Commission an update on planning for the 2021-2022 coastal steelhead season. The presentation will summarize the schedule for public meetings and pre-season planning lead by WDFW staff. Additionally, plans to increase monitoring of the steelhead sport fishery in order to reduce uncertainty in estimates of catch and effort will be discussed.
