- For QUICK REPORTING (by 10am the day following landing), NOTICE OF INTENT, and reporting GREEN STURGEON or STEELHEAD ENCOUNTERS USE: Telephone 1-866-791-1280, Fax 360-249-1229; or email <a href="mailto:harborfishtickets@dfw.wa.gov">harborfishtickets@dfw.wa.gov</a>
- Notice of Intent to fish any opener during 2020 is REQUIRED by 5 p.m. August 31, 2020.
- All participants **MUST** have attended a "Fish Friendly" best fishing practices workshop and have their department-issued certification card in their immediate possession.
