### Friday, July 16, 2021

#### A. Executive Session

#### B. University of Washington (UW) Periodic Wolf Status Review – Briefing

Donny Martorello, Ph.D., Wolf Policy Lead, Sarah Converse, Associate Professor/Leader with the Washington Cooperative Fish and Wildlife Research Unit, Beth Gardner, UW Associate Professor briefed the Commission on the status of the modeling tool that will be used by WDFW to make a recommendation for wolf status review.

Commissioner Koontz asked if genetics information is being considered in the model. Dr. Petracca indicated not at this time. Donny Martorello offered to forward to the Commissioners the recent wolf genetics data.

The full Commission will be briefed on the outcome of the modeling tool at the September 16-18, 2021, meeting.
