

For the week beginning Sunday October 24 all areas are closed except as follows:

Area 6D (Dungeness Bay) will be open to:

Skiff gillnets using 5-inch minimum mesh:

7 AM to 7 PM Daily Monday, October 25 - Friday, October 29 All Chinook must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

Areas 7B (Bellingham Bay) will be open to:

Gillnets using 5-inch minimum mesh:

Open continuously: 7 AM Tuesday October 26 – 4 PM Thursday October 28

Purse seines - with a 5 inch strip:

7 AM – 6 PM Wednesday October 27

Area 9A (Port Gamble Bay) will be open to:

Skiff gillnets with nets not to exceed 600 feet in length and 60 meshes in depth using 5-inch minimum mesh, is open continuously through 7 PM Saturday, October 30. All Chinook and chum must be released by cutting the ensnaring mesh.

Areas 10 and 11 (South Sound) will be open to:

Gillnets using 6 1/4 -inch minimum mesh size

5 PM to 9 AM Nightly Tuesday, October 26 Thursday, October 28

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip

7 AM to 6 PM Monday, October 25

Areas 12 and 12B (Hood Canal) will be open to:

Gillnets using 6 ¹/₄ -inch minimum mesh size

7 AM to 8 PM Daily Tuesday, October 26 Thursday, October 28

Purse seines with a 5 inch strip
