| Season: | Closed to retention effective March 11, 2022 |
| Area: | Mainstem Columbia River from Bonneville Dam to The Dalles Dam, and all adjacent tributaries |
| Reason for Action: | Creel data indicates that 621 out of the 675 fish guideline (92%) have been caught through Wednesday, March 9; and therefore, there is not enough fish remaining on the guideline to support the previously scheduled opening on Wednesday, March 16 in Bonneville Pool. |
| Additional Information: | Bonneville Pool remains open for catch-and-release fishing for sturgeon on days not open to retention, as do many other stretches of the Columbia. Fishing for sturgeon at night is prohibited. |

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A Joint State Hearing is scheduled for 2 PM March 30, 2022 to consider the Estuary recreational white sturgeon fishery.
- The Joint Staff will monitor fisheries and recommend additional hearings as needed.
