220-415-070 2021 Moose seasons, permit quotas, and areas.

WAC 220-415-070 Moose seasons, permit quotas, and areas

Proposed Change:

- 1. Exclude Parker Lake from the "49 Degrees North" hunt area
 - Large-scale timber treatment in Parker Lake area that will reduce hunt quality (once-in-a-lifetime hunt). Exclusion will cease with timber operations.
- 2. Include GMU 139 in the "Hangman" and "Cheney B" hunts
 - Expanded moose distribution warrants inclusion, also assists with occasional human-moose conflict.

Public comment

Common themes:

- General agreement over proposed changes
- General disagreement over proposed changes
- Sentiment that the change in the Parker Lake hunt area is unnecessary
- Concern over lost opportunity due to hunt area change
- Concern that the hunt area will not be restored post-timber harvest
- Support for expanding hunt areas/opportunity (Cheney hunt area)

GMAC input: 100% agree with proposed changes

WAC 220-415-130 Mountain goat seasons, permit quotas, and areas

Proposed Change:

- Suspension of the "Conflict reduction" special permits (Olympic Peninsula)
- 2. Reduce the "Goat Rocks East" hunt from 2 permits to 1
- 3. Recommended adjustment: reduce the "North Lake Chelan" hunt permits from 2 to 1

Public comment

Common themes:

- General support for the proposed changes
- General disagreement with the proposed changes
- Request for improved monitoring or research
- Request for expanded hunting opportunity
- Disapproval regarding conflict reduction hunt elimination
- Desire to allow hunters to conduct mountain goat depopulation on the Olympic Peninsula
- Concern regarding point accrual and point transfer among categories

GMAC input: 83% (10/12) agree with proposed changes

- Concern regarding de-population of Olympic Peninsula mountain goats



WAC 220-415-120 Bighorn sheep seasons, permit quotas, and areas

Proposed Changes:

- 1. Reduce "Any Ram" permits in Selah Butte, Umtanum, Cleman Mtn, and Quilomene hunts
- 2. Eliminate Selah Butte and Umtanum "adult ewe," "juvenile ram," and "youth" permits
- 3. Suspend the Vulcan Mtn "Any Ram" hunt
- 4. Include GMU 186 and portions of 181 in the Mountain View Black Butte "Any Ram" hunt area

Public comment

Common themes:

- General support
- Concern over impacts of disease to bighorn
- Opposition to limiting youth opportunities
- Concern about opportunity loss
- Concern about point accrual
- Preference for pausing hunts, rather than eliminating
- Concern over predation impacts to ungulate populations
- Concern regarding tribal hunting
- Desire for archery-only bighorn hunts
- Concern for limiting opportunity for disabled hunters
- Concern about domestic livestock risk to bighorn
