# WAC 220-413-030 Importation and retention of dead nonresident wildlife

**Proposed Changes:** 

- 1. Include caribou in the list of species with importation restrictions
- 2. Broaden importation restrictions for deer, elk, moose, and caribou carcasses (or parts) to any area outside of Washington state

(c) To import or possess deer, elk, ((<del>or</del>)) moose, or caribou, or parts thereof, harvested ((in Alberta, Arkansas, Colorado, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Saskatchewan, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, West Virginia, Wisconsin, and Wyoming)) outside Washington state, with the following exceptions:

# Common themes:

- General support
- General disagreement
- Lack of belief that CWD can be prevented from establishment by this rule change
- Concern over onerous requirements regarding harvest processing
- Concern that out of state hunting becomes more difficult
- Concern that the rule won't be effective or enforceable
- Sentiment that existing rules work and a change is unnecessary
- Concern over feeding and baiting
- Concern over the impacts of predation on ungulates
- Confusion over the proposal (comments about banning baiting or feeding)
