Background summary:

WDFW received a petition to amend WAC 220-414-100. The petitioner would like to see the following changes:

Allow hunters that are 65 years or older to use a crossbow during the deer and elk archery seasons.

Staff recommendation:

WDFW recommeds denying the petition. The Department usually addresses these types of requests during our 3-year season setting process. This is not a new issue and one that the department has considered in the past. Based on public input the department did not recommend this approach. This is a controversial issue that requires sufficient outreach which can best be accomplished during the 3-year season setting process. WDFW will put forth this idea for public review again the next 3-year season setting process which begins the Spring of 2023.

Policy issue(s) and expected outcome:

If the petition is denied the department will work through the already outlined 3-year season setting process to address this request.
