Background summary:
At this briefing, staff will present for approval operating and capital budget requests for the 2023 legislative session. This will include both the second supplemental budget and the biennial budgets for the 23-25 biennium. The 2023 Supplemental budget ends June 30, 2023, and the 23-25 Biennial Budget starts July 1, 2023. Each request was developed using the Strategic Plan and Foundational Map. The dollar amounts may have small changes before submission to OFM in September.
Staff recommendation:

A majority of the Commission may add ideas for additional requests by specifying the outcomes they'd hope to see and the activities they anticipate might bring about those outcomes. Staff can then report on cost and strategy during the August Commission for final approval.


