

2021 Summary of Willapa Bay Fall Commercial Fishery Schedule

The following are in effect for ALL commercial openers in Willapa Bay:

- **Retention of STURGEON OR STEELHEAD is PROHIBITED**. ALL encounters MUST be reported to Wholesale Buyer or Quick Reporting.
- For QUICK REPORTING (required by 10am the day following landing), NOTICE OF INTENT, and reporting GREEN STURGEON or STEELHEAD ENCOUNTERS USE: Telephone 1-866-791-1280, Fax 360-249-1229; or email harborfishtickets@dfw.wa.gov
- Notice of Intent to fish any opener during 2021 is REQUIRED by <u>5 p.m. August 6, 2021</u>.
- All participants <u>MUST</u> have attended a "Fish Friendly" best fishing practices workshop and have their department-issued certification card in their immediate possession.
- <u>RELEASE</u> ALL NATURAL (UNMARKED) CHINOOK, ALL STEELHEAD, and ALL STURGEON
- Live boxes are required to be used on-board for Wild (unmarked) Chinook and All Steelhead prior to release.
- Soak times are limited to 45 minutes (when first buoy enters the water until buoy is fully retrieved from the water)

Area 2T:

When fishing Area 2T, the following rule applies: Those waters north of a line from Toke Point channel marker 3, easterly through Willapa Harbor channel marker 13 (green), then northeasterly to the power transmission pole located at 46°43.1907'N, 123°50.83134'W) are **CLOSED to fishing September 16 through September 30, 2021**.
