Purpose of Game Management Plans

- Guide the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife's management of hunted wildlife.
- Provide the public an opportunity to weigh-in through a formal process on high level game management issues.
- Identify data gaps and future research and monitoring needs.
- Provide direction on sustainable hunting management.
- Identify existing and potential limiting factors affecting game populations.
- Give broad direction on addressing known limiting factors.
- Provide a basis for work planning.
- Identify funding needs.



High level Summary of Steps

- Overarching plan and individual species and guild plans that will be produced over a specific time period
- All plans will go through SEPA using a phased review approach
- Commission will contemplate policy considerations that may inform individual plans
- Wildlife Committee/Commission will provide case appropriate review during the internal review process prior to public SEPA review

Committee

- Overall guidance for game management plans
- Review draft objectives
- Identify policy choices for Commission consideration
- Recommend when a plan may require a formal policy to Commission
- Develop draft policies for Commission consideration

Commission

- Receive periodic updates on progress
- Approve Commission policies originating through Committee process
- Vote on policy choices brought to Commission from Committee

- Internally evaluated and updated the Issue Statements from the existing GMP
- Identified Authors and process owners for the new Game Management Plans
- Mapped the timelines for current and future work
- Completed the human dimensions survey


