DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) AND ADOPTION OF EXISTING ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT (ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT)

Name of Proposal: DNS/Adoption 22-048: KACHESS DAM SAFETY OF DAMS

MODIFICATIONS

Description of Proposal:

The U.S. Bureau of Reclamation identified seepage and internal erosion issues through the Kachess Dam embankment along the outlet works conduit, which conveys water from the reservoir to the Kachess River downstream (see drawings for more detail). Reclamation is proposing to rectify the issue by:

- Constructing an access road and installing a box culvert
- Improving the outfall structure, including the following activities:
- Extending and lining the conduit
- Installing a diaphragm filter around the conduit
- Constructing a stability berm on top of the filter
- Installing an auxiliary drain below the outlet channel
- Removing a weir and improving the tributary channel to the Kachess River
- Revegetating after construction activities

WDFW has made a Determination of Non-Significance, and is adopting a NEPA Environmental Assessment under SEPA rules.
