WASHINGTON COASTAL DUNGENESS CRAB INDUSTRY NOTICE

Season Opening Delayed in Washington, Oregon

On December 22, 2022, coastal Dungeness crab Tri-State policy representatives from the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW), the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) agreed to delay the opening of the 2022-23 Coastal Dungeness crab fishery from Oregon/California border north to the US/Canada border through at least January 15, 2023. This decision was based on crab condition tests conducted by WDFW, ODFW, and CDFW which shows that test results at multiple sites across the region do not currently meet the minimum meat recovery criteria.

The Tri-State Dungeness Crab Pre-Season Testing Protocols specify that after the third round of testing, if any area does not meet the minimum meat recovery criteria (23% north of Cascade Head and 24% south of Cascade Head) a delay is required, and additional testing is conducted before a season opening date can be confirmed. WDFW will provide additional information regarding the season opening as soon as possible following the completion of the upcoming tests.

The area between Point Arena, CA and the Oregon/California border will open on December 31, 2022. Any vessel that begins fishing in the area between Point Arena, CA, and the California/Oregon Border before the area north of the Oregon/California border opens will be delayed 30 days before being allowed to fish in the area between the Oregon/California border and Klipsan Beach, WA.

WASHINGTON TEST RESULTS

The stations in the Long Beach test areas were completed on December 22, 2022. The results for all stations are summarized below. The results were delayed by one day due to weather and no shell condition data was collected due to illness-related issues with several WDFW staff.

WDFW made the decision not to conduct another test in the Westport stations. This decision was also based on poor weather conditions and the same illness-related issues with several WDFW staff.

On Sunday December 18, 2022, Quinault Indian Nation (QIN) opened their commercial Dungeness crab fishery within their U&A (between Point Chehalis and Destruction Island) after their final meat recovery test results came back at 23.4%. In addition, on December 15, we finalized our 2022-23 State/Tribal crab management agreement with QIN. This agreement has the same provisions as the 2021-22 agreement. We are required to hold a State/QIN discussion to use the first 30 days of QIN catch to determine the total QIN head-start days. After that discussion, we will provide you the opening details for the area north of Klipsan.
