2023 Mainstem Columbia River Spring Chinook Recreational Fishery	
Downstream of Bonneville Dam	
Season:	Thursday May 25 through Sunday June 4 11 days
Area:	Tongue Point/Rocky Point line upstream to Beacon Rock (boat and bank) plus bank angling only from Beacon Rock upstream to the Bonneville Dam deadline. Legal upstream boat boundary defined as: A deadline marker on the Oregon bank (approximately four miles downstream from Bonneville Dam Powerhouse One) in a straight line through the western tip of Pierce Island to a deadline marker on the Washington bank at Beacon Rock.
Daily Bag Limit:	Two adult hatchery salmonids (Chinook or steelhead) per day, but only one may be a Chinook. All previously adopted regulations, including permanent regulations, remain in effect.

FUTURE MEETINGS

• The Compact/Joint State hearing is scheduled for 11 AM June 1, 2023 to consider additional non-treaty spring Chinook fisheries.
