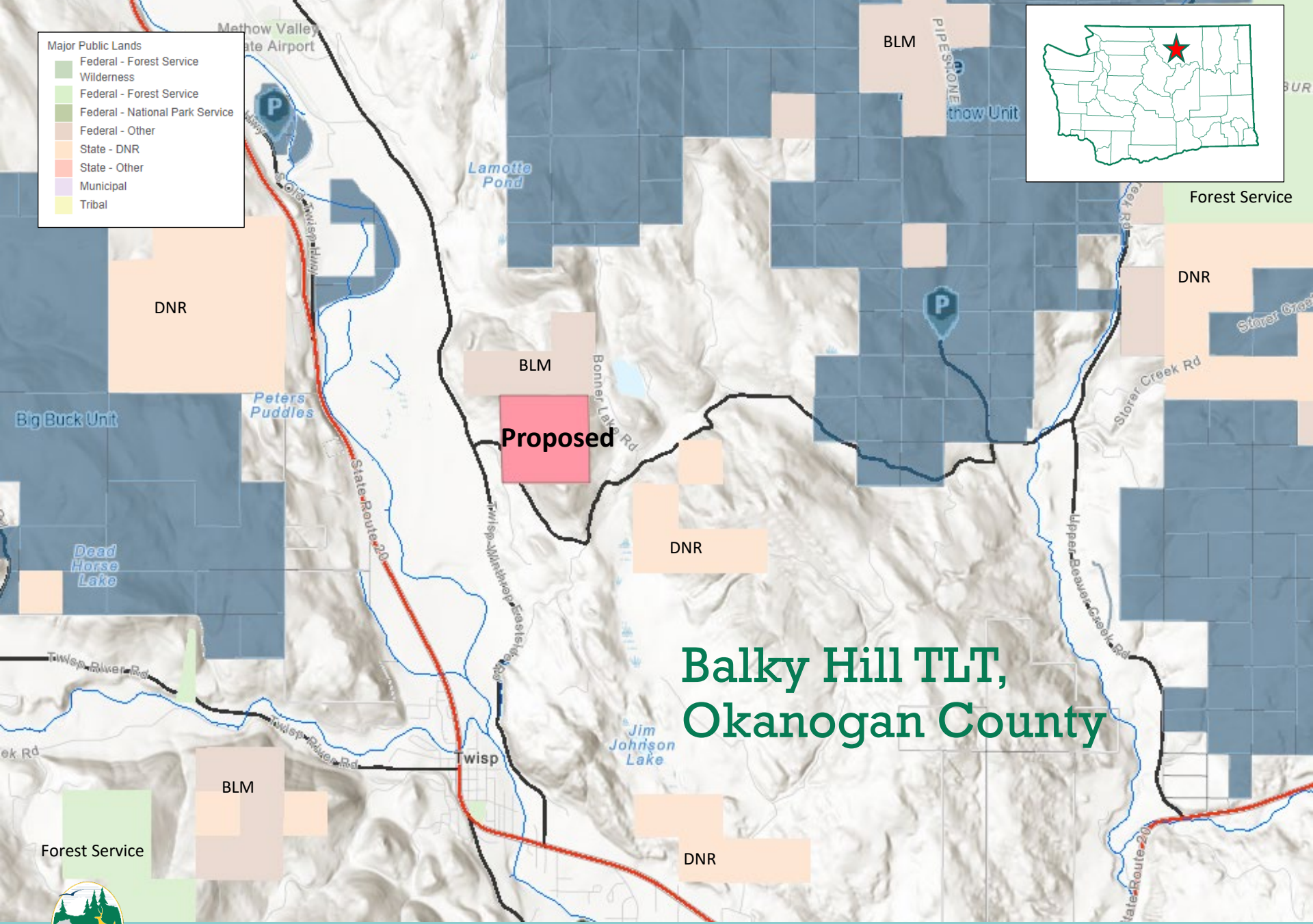
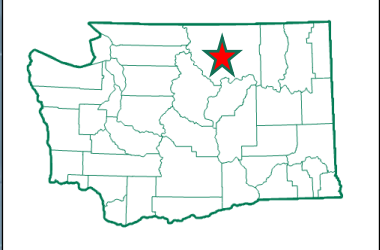

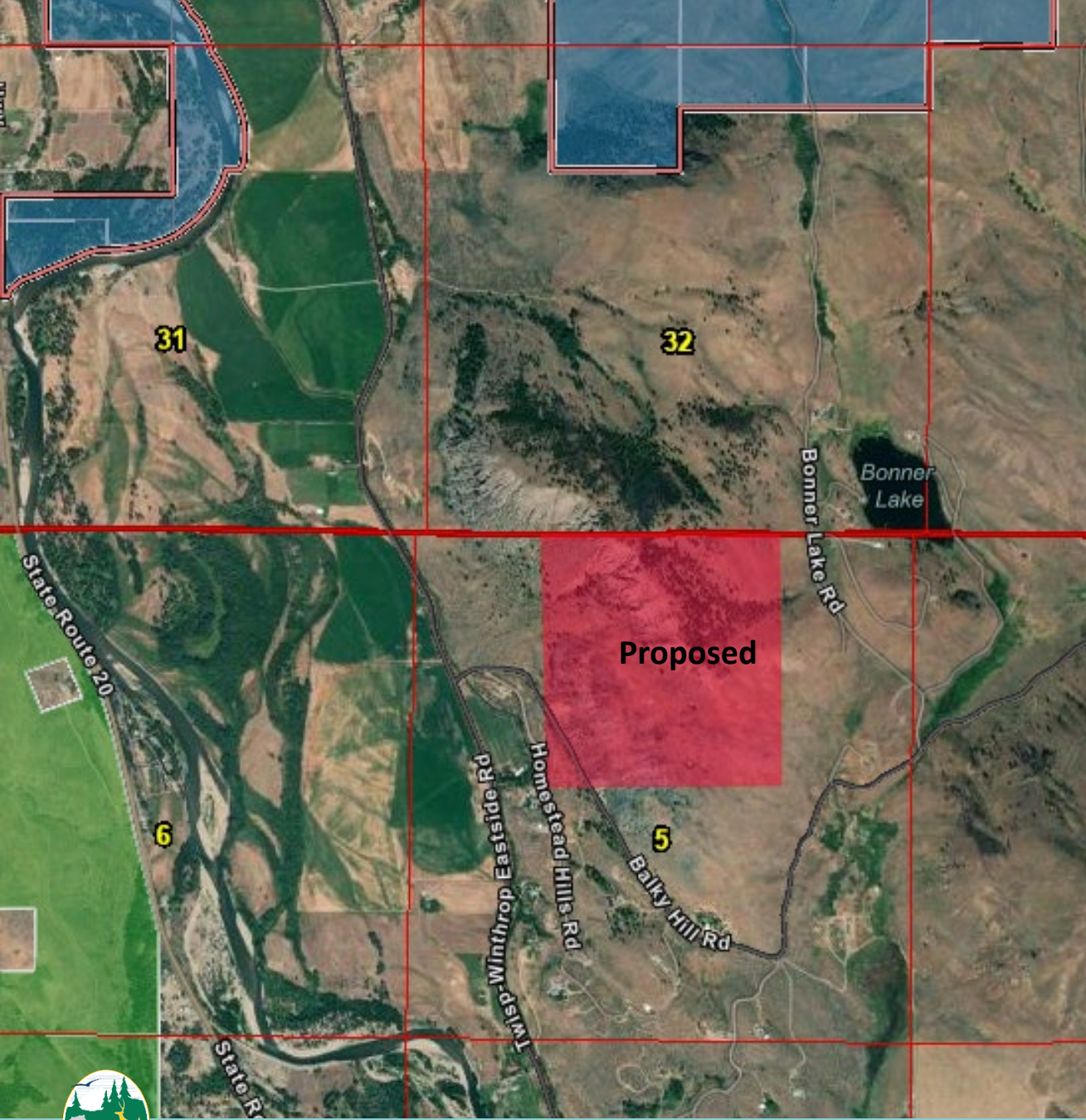

- This proposed acquisition is to acquire 160 acres to be managed as part of the Methow Unit of the Methow Wildlife Area.

- This proposed acquisition project provides critical shrubsteppe habitat, known golden eagle nesting habitat, and links to existing public lands and conservation easement land that provide critical wildlife movement corridors.
- Along with golden eagle, this area is also known to be the home of mule deer, gray wolf and grouse.
- Recreational opportunities include wildlife viewing, nature photography, fishing, big game hunting and upland bird hunting for pheasant and grouse.
