

Tri-State Protocols

- North of Cascade Head: Meat recovery rate for each test area to reach 23 percent (no rounding).
- South of Cascade Head: Meat recovery rate for each test area to reach 24 percent (no rounding).
- Third Round of Test Fishing: scheduled for completion by December 22 call today at 11:30
- Agency Directors or their designees will discuss the results and <u>mutually decide to open the season on: December 31, January 15 or February 1.</u>
- If every test area meets the minimum meat recovery criteria: Open on December 31.
- If every test area is greater than or equal to 23% (no rounding) meat recovery: Open on January 15.
- If there are test areas that are below 23% or the third round of test fishing was not completed, but there are significant threats to the fishery forecast (whales, biotoxin, etc): Open on January 15.
- If there are test areas that are below 23% and there are insignificant known threats to the fishery forecast (whales, biotoxin, etc): Tri-State protocols prescribe the season open on February 1.



Tri-State Season Opening

- States have the option to conduct a fourth round of test fishing and use the results to open the season on January 15 or February 1
- The next round of test fishing will be scheduled for completion by January 7
- Expect that ODFW will want another round of test fishing
- Like last year, unlikely to reach 23% in S.
 WA (see slide #4)





State-Quinault Agreement – Inseason Management

SMA Revisions

- 1. A minimum adjustment to the western boundary of 10 fathoms will be a first step.
- a. Alternative or additional adjustments may be made if agreed to by both parties.
- 2. A minimum adjustment to the southern and northern boundary of five miles will be a first step.
- a. Alternative or additional adjustment may be made if agreed to by both parties.

Pot Limits

Pot limit adjustments may be used to increase or decrease opportunity.

Pot limits for the State fleet will not exceed permanent pot limit assignments of 300 or 500 pots.
