PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Beginning Jan 1, 2018 all participating members of the group will need to attend, or be represented in 75% of group meetings. Each of the group members will serve a two-year term, and can request to serve additional terms. All WDFW recreational license dealers that are interested are allowed to request to be members of the Dealer Advisory Group. Final approval for membership will be decided by the Licensing Division Manager, Sales and Marketing Manager, and Dealer Account Representatives.
