- Planning to add an ADA wildlife viewer to the unit.

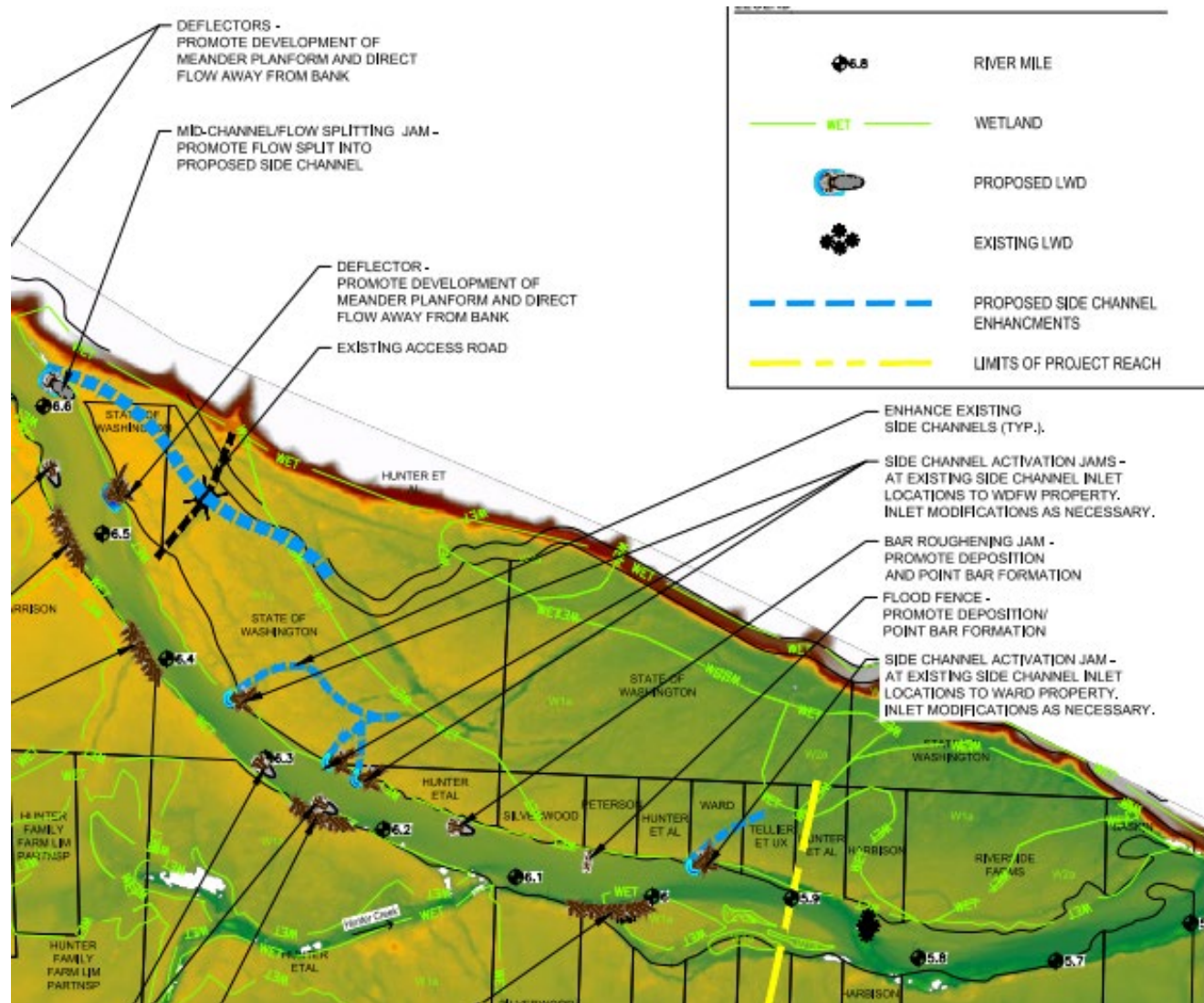




Skokomish: Regular Cleanups



Skokomish: Proposed Floodplain Restoration



Proposed:

- 22 engineered log jams in the mainstem Skokomish River
- Creation of 0.9 miles of new side channel,
- Installation of 13 side channel log structures.
- A new parking area for continued recreation will be built farther upland and the vault toilet will be moved farther upland to free up wetland area and floodplain activation activity.

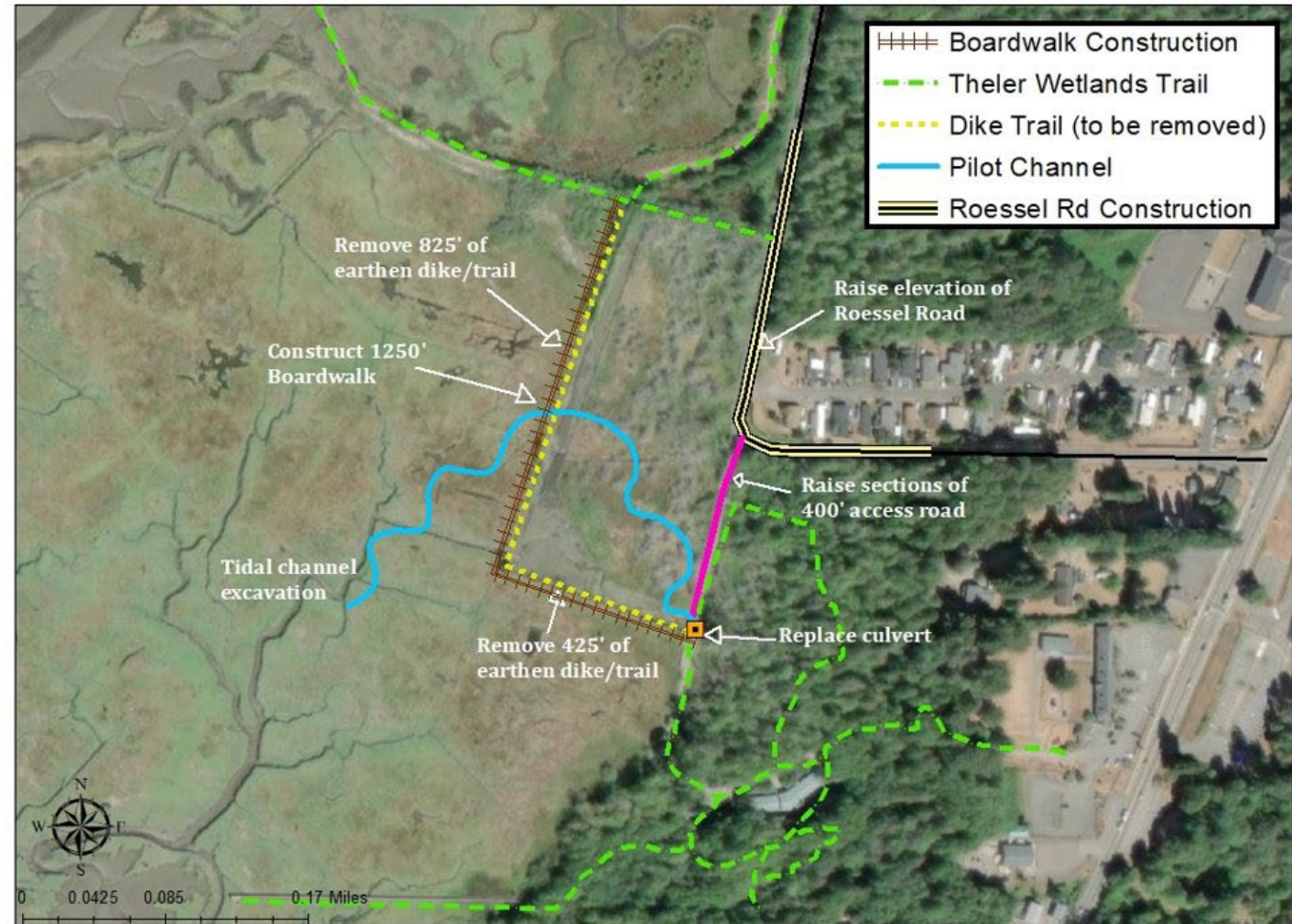
