




Moose Management

- Stable & expanding moose population



Population Assessment




Bighorn Sheep Management



Bighorn Sheep, Vulcan herd

- Thirteen hunted populations
- Intensive monitoring of populations size and production
- Harvest mature rams when ram populations are meeting objectives
 - ✓ Herd > 50 bighorns
 - ✓ 8 rams > $\frac{1}{2}$ curl & 2 > $\frac{3}{4}$ curl
 - √ 10-20% of mature rams
- Stable bighorn sheep populations

Bighorn Sheep Herds





Mountain goat capture

- Annual surveys
- Population management units
- Restrict harvest when population status is declining or unknown
- Conservative harvest in areas with stable or increasing populations
 - √ ≥100 individuals
 - √ 1-4% of population
