A. Puget Sound Recreational Clam and Oyster Season Changes – Rule Adoption:

The Commission considered adoption of permanent amendments to the Puget Sound Recreational Clam and Oyster Season presented by Rich Childers, Shellfish Policy Manager.

**Chair Wecker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mahnken to adopt the permanent amendments to the Puget Sound Recreational Clam and Oyster Season WAC 220-56-350 Clams other than razor clams, mussels – Areas and seasons and WAC 220-56-380 Oysters–Areas and seasons. The motion carried unanimously.**

B. 2012 Triploid Trout Stocking Plan – Decision:

Commission considered the proposed 2012 triploid trout stocking plan for final adoption presented by Craig Burley, Fish Management Division Manager.
