

 Provide recreational hunting opportunities to annually harvest at least 800-1,200 bears statewide, while at the same time maintaining a sustainable bear population in each BBMU



Statewide Fall Bear Harvest




Statewide Spring Bear Harvest


Spring Seasons and Tree Depredation Kills



Black bear Management Units






