#### BACKGROUND

#### Oregon Initiative 81

- On the November Oregon Ballot
- Bans gillnet and tangle net gear in all Oregon inland waters
- Allows fixed gear and seines
- Future recreational fishery allocation at least equal to the 07-11 average

## Governor Kitzhaber Proposal

- Governor asks Oregon FWC to take action and develop rules to:
  - Phase out non-tribal gillnets in the mainstem Col River-Transition period of 2013-16
  - Adopt Selective sport fishery as primary management approach in mainstem Col River
  - Adopt Commercial fishery as primary management approach in off-channel areas
  - Address commercial mainstem opportunities with more selective gear

# Governor Kitzhaber proposal

- Primary Steps in Governor Kitzhaber proposal
  - Work in concert with Washington for concurrent policy and sharing of investment and benefits
  - Shift salmon production to off-channel areas.
  - Enhance off-channel boundaries and/or locations
  - 2013-16 Transition period to keep commercial fishery economically stable
  - Modest shift of impacts to sport fishery during transition period
  - Final Outcome intended to benefit both sport and commercial fisheries

## Proposed Washington/Oregon process

- WA/OR Directors met in August to develop a joint state process
- Timeline for initial policy development and consideration is September-December
- Convene a Working Group including:
  - Three Commissioners from each state
  - WDFW and ODFW Directors and senior staff
  - Four advisors from each state
  - A contracted facilitator

### Proposed WA/OR Process Schedule

- September 4-Joint staff meeting to prepare for Working Group
- September 21- Work Group meeting in Olympia
- Late October- Work Group meeting in Salem
- November 1-15- Commission discussion/public comments
- November 16-30- Work Group or joint Commission meeting
- December- Commissions adopt policies
