
Hunting Restrictions WAC 232-12-242 Rule Action

#### • Overview:

- Dogs may be used during general seasons for Raccoon, Rabbit, Hare
- Night hunting is legal for some species such as coyote, bobcat and raccoon
- Conflicts during modern firearm deer and elk seasons

#### • Overview:

- Rule was removed from 232-28-342
- Not reinserted elsewhere as planned
- Rule reduces hunter conflicts and illegal activity



#### Proposal:

- Reinstate hound/night hunting restrictions
  - Applies only during modern firearm deer/elk seasons
  - Reduces conflict between hunters
  - Lessens potential for unlawful hunting
- Place with other hunting restrictions

### Floor Change:

### Concern raised regarding small game hunters

(2) (a) It is unlawful to hunt any wildlife at night or wild ani-

mals, except rabbits and hares, with dogs (hounds) during the months

of September, October, or November in any area open to a modern fire-

arm deer or elk season. A violation of this subsection is punishable

under RCW 77.15.430, Unlawful hunting of wild animals-Penalty.
