4. Conservation and Sustainable Fisheries Plan - Briefing

Cindy Le Fleur, Region 5 Fish Program Manager and Pat Frazier, Region 5 Policy Coordinator briefed the Commission on actions taken in the lower Columbia River to implement the Hatchery and Fishery Reform Policy C-3619.

5. Hunter Education Deferrals – Briefing and Public Hearing

Dave Whipple, Hunter Education Division Manager, briefed the Commission on the hunter education deferral process to amend WAC 232-12-228 in an effort to improve rule clarity and enhance customer service. No public input.

6. Migratory Bird Hunting Regulations and Closures – Briefing and Public Hearing

Don Kraege, Waterfowl Section Manager, briefed the Commission on proposed updates and amendments to migratory bird hunting seasons and regulations and on an amendment to the boundary description of a closure on the Snake River. No public input.

10. Deer Areas, Elk Areas, Special Closures and Firearm Restriction Areas, and Hunting by persons with a Disability – Briefing and Public Hearing

Jerry Nelson, Deer and Elk Section Manager briefed the Commission on proposed amendments to deer and elk area descriptions, firearm restrictions in Grays Harbor County and conditions under which hunters with disabilities may shoot from a vehicle. No public input.
