# 2018 Spring Bear Seasons and Regulations

# Background

- Spring black bear permits:
  - Distribute hunting pressure and harvest
  - Lessen tree damage on industrial timberlands
- Changing timing for determining hunts
  - Typically in March with game hunting seasons
  - More responsive to management needs
  - Process for participants remains the same
  - Announced in 2017 Big Game Hunting Season & Regulations pamphlet (hard copy and online versions)
  - Recommendations for 2018; 2017 season has ended

 Summary: Outlines the requirements related to participating in spring black bear hunts through a black bear special permit; which successful harvest applies towards the annual 2 bear bag limit.




#### **Proposed Change:**

Extend the season ending date to June 15 for GMUs
154, 162, 166, 169, 172, 175, 181, and 186.

#### Rationale:

 To mitigate damage, improve distribution of harvest, and provide consistency and simplify the regulation for participants.



#### **Proposed Change:**

- Remove the Monroe hunt in GMU 448.
- Reduce the number of permits for the Long Beach hunt, GMU 684, from 20 permits to 12 permits.

#### Rationale:

 The Department has determined past damage mitigation efforts have been successful in diminishing damage occurrences and reducing hunting pressure is recommended.



#### **Proposed Changes:**

- Add GMUs 638 and 648
   (excluding US Forest Service lands), to the Copalis hunt
   (GMU 642).
- Rationale: To improve distribution of hunting pressure across areas where damage mitigation and harvest is needed.



## **Next Steps**

- Develop and distribute hunt area announcement
  - November 2017
  - Information to all vendors and licensed hunters (email, web site, fact sheet)
- Activate special permit process (no change in process)
  - Application
  - Drawing
  - Announcement of selected hunters
- Review results of 2018 season and prepare recommendations for 2019
