## A. Columbia River Policy Review – Next Steps and Follow Up

Contact was made with Oregon on November 5, 2018 and we are waiting for a response. This item was delayed until the December 7<sup>th</sup> conference call.

## B. <u>Meeting Minute Approval – Decision</u>

The Commission considered approval of the October 15, and November 1-3, 2018 meetings.

## C. <u>General Discussion</u>

- Briefing on "what is possible" towards a time frame of implementing a proposal for approximately 50 million smolts, taking into consideration current and forthcoming capacity at hatchery facilities.
