Season:	6:00 a.m. Tuesday June 10 until 6:00 p.m. Thursday June 12, 2014 (2.5 days)
Allowable Sales:	Salmon, steelhead, shad, walleye, carp, catfish, bass, and yellow perch may be sold or kept for subsistence. Sturgeon between 43-54 inches fork length harvested in The Dalles or John Day Pools and sturgeon between 38-54 inches fork length in the Bonneville pool may not be sold but may be kept for subsistence.
Gear:	Gill nets. No mesh restriction
Sanctuaries: Miscellaneous:	Standard dam and river mouth sanctuaries in effect for this gear type except for the Spring Creek Hatchery sanctuary which is not necessary this time of year. 24-hour quick reporting required for Washington wholesale dealers, pursuant to WAC 220-69-240, except landings must be reported within 24-hours of completing the fish ticket.
	 Submission of a report is not complete until the report arrives at the designated department location.
