The Joint States met today and took the following action:

Columbia River Buoy 10 Recreational Fishery

Effective Friday October 3 through December 31, 2014:

In the area from Buoy 10 upstream to the Tongue Point/Rocky Point the daily bag limit will include up to 3 adult hatchery coho.

All other permanent regulations remain in place.

• (Revised) Daily Bag limit: Minimum size is 12 inches. Daily salmonid limit is 6 fish. Up to 3 may be adults, of which no more than 2 may be adult Chinook or hatchery steelhead or 1 of each. Release all wild coho

Future Hearings:

A Columbia River Compact is scheduled via teleconference for 10 AM Wednesday, October 8 to consider treaty and non-Indian fisheries.
