THE FOLLOWING ACTION WAS TAKEN:

2015 Non-Indian Sturgeon Recreational Fisheries

Effective Saturday July 18 until further notice: Angling for and retention of sturgeon will be prohibited in the waters of the Columbia River and adjacent tributaries from Bonneville Dam upstream to the Oregon/Washington border.

In a separate action Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife announced identical regulations for the geographic areas including the Columbia River and adjacent tributaries upstream of the Oregon/Washington border and for the Washington waters in the lower Snake River, including all adjacent tributaries.

- A hearing is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. Monday July 20 to consider treaty commercial fisheries.
- A fall Compact hearing is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. Wednesday July 29, 2015 at the Clark Regional Wastewater District (8000 52nd Court, Vancouver, Washington).
