The States met today and took the following action:

2015 Mainstem Columbia River Summer Chinook Recreational Fishery

Season: Open through July 31, 2015

Area: Astoria-Megler Bridge upstream to the Bonneville Dam deadline.

Daily Bag Through July 2: Two adult salmonids.

Limit: Sockeye are included in the adult daily limit

Chinook and steelhead must be adipose fin clipped.

July 3-31: Two adult salmonids, only one may be a Chinook

Sockeye are included in the adult daily limit.

Steelhead must be adipose fin clipped.

2015 Mainstem Columbia River Summer Chinook Recreational Fishery

Effective July 3, 2015: in the area from Bonneville Dam upstream to the Oregon/Washington border the daily bag limit will include: Two adult salmonids, only one may be a Chinook. Sockeye are included in the adult daily limit. Steelhead must be adipose fin clipped.
