The ongoing Treaty Winter Fishery in Bonneville Pool was modified to discontinue the sale of salmon after 6 p.m. Thursday March 12. The following describes the resulting season:

Treaty Indian Winter Fishery - Bonneville Pool	
Season	Immediately until 6:00 p.m. March 21, 2015
Area:	SMCRA 1F (Bonneville Pool)
Gear:	Gill nets (no mesh restriction), hoop nets, dip bag nets, and rod and reel with hook and line. Fish caught during the open period may be sold after the period concludes.
Allowable Sales:	Through 6:00 pm Thursday March 12: Salmon, Steelhead, shad, carp, catfish, walleye, bass, and yellow perch. Sturgeon from 38 to 54 inches fork length in the Bonneville Pool may be sold or kept for subsistence purposes. Live release of all oversize and under-size sturgeon is required. Fish caught during the open period may be sold after the period concludes.
	Effective 6:01 p.m. Thursday March 12: Sales of Salmon are prohibited. Salmon may be kept for ceremonial and subsistence purposes only.
Sanctuaries:	River mouth and Dam sanctuaries remain in effect and apply to all species.
Quick Report:	Quick reporting required for all Washington Fish Buyers pursuant to WAC 220-69-240.14(d), and landings must be quick reported within 24-hours of completing the fish ticket (not 24-hours after the period concludes).
