THE FOLLOWING SEASON WAS MODIFIED:

<i>2016 Buoy 10 Recreational Fishery</i>	
Action:	Effective through September 14: Retention of Chinook is allowed.
Area:	From a true north and south line through Buoy 10 upstream to a projected line from Rocky Point of the Washington Shore through Red Buoy # 44 to the navigation light at Tongue Point on the Oregon bank.
Daily Bag Limit:	Chinook minimum size 24-inches. Coho minimum size 16-inches. Daily limit is two fish of which only one may be a Chinook. Only one hatchery steelhead may be retained per day. Release all salmon other than Chinook and adipose fin-clipped Coho.

- The tribes have requested a hearing be scheduled September 14 or September 15 to consider sales of fish in additional treaty commercial fisheries.
